SUZANNE ARCHER – AFTERLIFE

AN MAITLAND REGIONAL ART GALLERY TOURING EXHIBITION

Afterlife is an exhibition of powerful paintings and sculptures where Archer interprets and re-shapes the skeletal remains of animals including birds, rats and horses. While the subject matter appears dark and morbid the end results are poetic and even fanciful prompting us to question

where souls go, rather than what happens to the bodies after death. Archer has won numerous awards including the 2010 *Dobell Prize for Drawing*, *The Wynne Prize 1994*, and a fellowship from the Visual Arts/ Craft Board, 1993.

WILD INTERIORS

AN EXHIBITION BY KATKA ADAMS

Katka Adams has created a series of visual fables exploring reconciliation ecology – the science of accommodating wild species within human-modified or occupied landscapes. This exhibition includes works on paper illustrating animals

within interior environs and pieces of furniture. Using pastel with an expressive line and limited colour palette, Adams' subjects are rendered with realism and have a strong narrative focus.

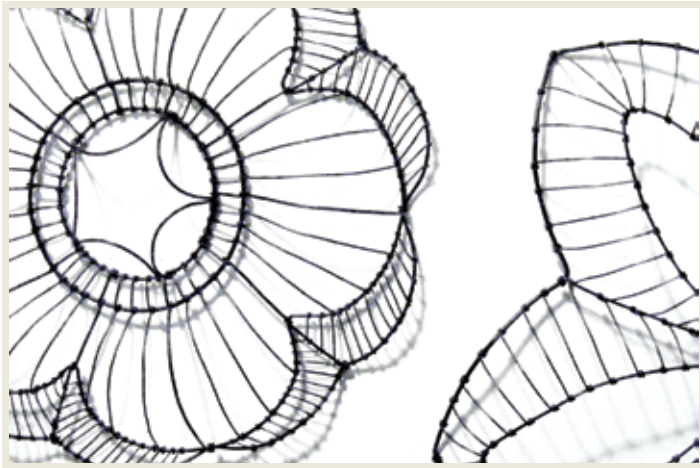

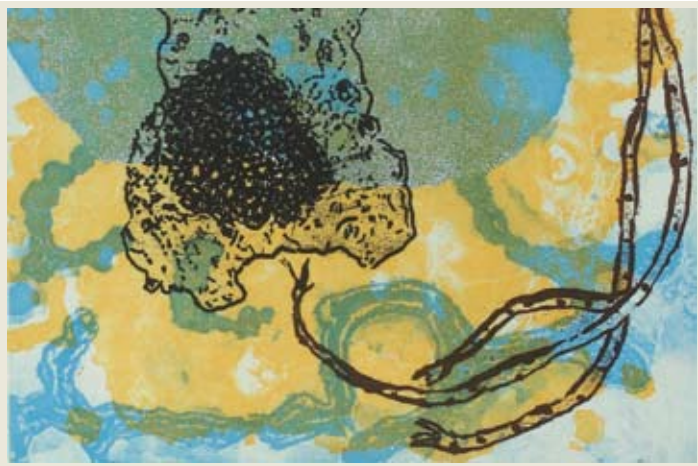

JUDY WATSON

HERON ISLAND SUITE 2009/2010

TEXT-BASED ARTWORKS BY ALAN JAMES

Alan James' artworks derive from a love of the iconography and vernacular of road signs – a desire first sparked by the work of Rosalie Gascoigne. Conceptually the artworks

respond to what the artist sees as an increasingly heartless, mindless, humourless world and encourage the viewer to think and reflect on standardised signage in everyday life.

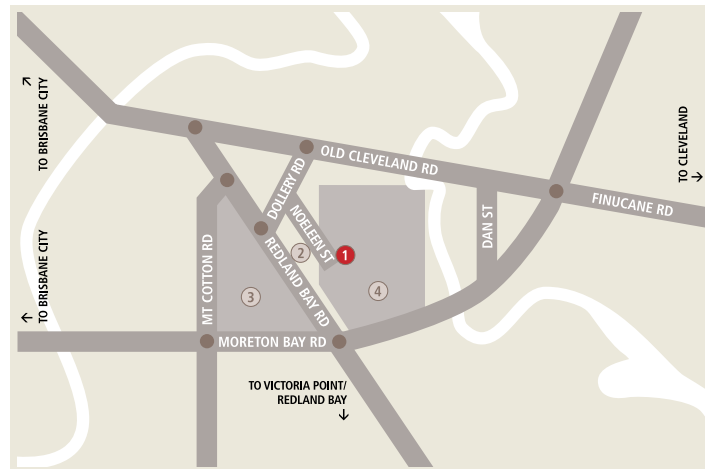
